The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - FROM JUBILEE DRVIE HEAD IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION, PAST CULM BRIDGE. TAKE A LEFT TURN AT FLASHFORD BRIDGE, HEAD WEST ALONG LOWER MILLHAYES. TURN LEFT ONTO STATION ROAD AND FOLLOW ROAD TO OTHER SIDE OF CLOSURE. FROM CLOSURE, HEAD NORTH UP STATION ROAD. TURN RIGHT INTO LOWER MILLHAYES AND FOLLOW TO FLASHFORD BRIDGE.
